

PARENT/GUARDIAN-STUDENT SCHOOL DANCE AGREEMENT

The administration and staff of St Ignatius CYO Board have been working diligently to insure that all students attending the RED ROSE DANCE have a safe, enjoyable time, free of any incidents which could interfere with a pleasant evening for all. Therefore, as many schools are now doing, we ask parents to review our established guidelines with their children and show their support by signing the form below prior to tickets being purchased.

We, as parents/guardians of _____ understand and agree to the rules and policies regarding students attending the RED ROSE DANCE which will be held on **Saturday, February 11th 2012**, from **7:00 pm to 11:00 pm** at **Toscani, 1101 Rocky Drive, West Lawn, PA**. We understand and agree that all school rules regarding behavior are in effect at the dance, and those students attending the dance should reflect standards of a Catholic School philosophy which is grounded in self-respect and respect for others, particularly regarding dress, behavior, language, and music.

DRESS: Boys will wear, dress slacks and dress shoes. a sport coat, tie are optional . Ties and dress shoes remain on, shirts remain buttoned and tucked.

Girls will wear dresses which are no shorter than two inches above the knee, contain no slits above the knee, no bare midriffs, cutouts or plunging/ low-cut, dresses revealing bodices or necklines.

DANCE AND BEHAVIOR: Students will not be permitted to act or dance in a sexually suggestive manner, e.g. grinding, freaking, groping, back to front, lap dancing, etc. What may be culturally popular and acceptable to some may not necessarily be appropriate at a Catholic High School dance. Attendees are limited to 9th and 10th Grade students and a single guest. All attendees should be 18 years old or under on February 11, 2012.

In addition, the use or influence of alcohol, tobacco or drugs is a violation school and legal codes. The school reserves the right to search handbags, etc., and administer breathalyzer tests throughout the evening to students through the supervision of the Wyomissing Police Department. Any student testing positive or refusing to submit to the test will have their parents contacted to be picked up. The school reserves the right to turn the matter over to local authorities for serious offenses.

Also throughout the evening, if a student ignores the warnings of inappropriate conduct, parents will be notified and students will be asked to leave the dance and wait in the lobby pending the arrival of their parents. No refunds will be given should this occur, and additional action through the school may occur.

Students are not permitted to leave/return or permanently leave the dance until 9:45 pm.

Prior upon final payment for the dance, this form signed by both student and parent must be submitted. No admission to the dance will be permitted unless both students and parents understand and agree to the above by signing and returning this form.
